

Transcript – Blow .05 And You Blow Over Television



Visual We open on a young man called Paul. He is in the bar area in a rec centre with his soccer team mates before a casual game. It's clear that this is a group of friends who make up a casual league. He's clearly excited about the upcoming game. A team mate offers him a beer, he declines.

Voice Over: So Paul, you said no to a beer before the game.

Visual: We cut to Paul after the game with his team mates, they're celebrating their win over a couple of beers. Paul is telling everyone about the game the way he saw it.

Voice Over: But after the game it's beer o'clock.

Visual: We cut back to Paul in goal, he is bouncing up and down saving goal attempts.

Voice Over: So, you need all your reflexes here.

Visual: We cut back to Paul, but he is now in his car driving home, singing to a song on the radio.

Voice Over: But not here.

Visual: We cut back to Paul in goal, he is bouncing up and down in anticipation.

Voice Over: Here you are like a cat.

Visual: We cut back to inside Paul's car as he tries to throw a chip in his mouth but misses.

Voice Over: That's not cat like.

Visual: We cut back to Paul in goals as he deflects an approaching ball with a head-butt. We then see him clapping his hands in support of his teammates on field.

Voice Over: Boom! Reflexes.

Visual: We cut back to inside Paul's car as he eyeball-challenges another driver.

Voice Over: Not so much.

Visual: We cut back to Paul in goal – as he does a one-arm body pull-up from the goal frame – emphasising his dominance.

Voice Over: This is good.

Visual: We cut back to Paul's car as he drums on the dashboard to a song on the radio.

Voice Over: This is bad.

Visual: We cut back to Paul in goals as he sprays his face with water to stay alert.

Voice Over: You're not going to blow it here.

Visual: We cut back to an external POV of Paul's car. As he is pulled over by police. POV then changes and we see Paul being breathalysed by police.

Voice Over: But here – yep.

Visual: We cut to Paul being escorted by police to the back of the police car. We see Paul's face, he looks ashamed.

SUPER: BLOW .05 AND YOU BLOW OVER.

Voice Over: Maybe you should stay as sharp in your car as you are in goal, Paul

Visual: Fade to black: SUPER Authorised by the State Government, Perth. Spoken by S. Curry.

Voice Over: Authorised by the State Government, Perth.
