

Transcript – Grow up Television



Visual Open on a male tradesman sitting at a table in a pub. He drinks down his beer and moves away.

Cut to see him remove some keys from his pocket.

Cut to see a child aged version of the same man walking to camera as he says:

Child Tradie: It's not like I'm off my face

Visual: Match cut to see a child businesswoman walking to camera as she says.

Child business

Woman: I've only had a few champagnes.

Visual: Match cut to see a male child dressed casually in what looks like a country pub walking to camera as he says.

Child Farmer: I'll be alright there's only one cop in town.

Visual: Match cut to see another male child dressed casually leaving a residential property, car keys in hand, walking to camera as he says.

Child house

party: I'll just take the back streets.

Visual: Match cut to see another male child businessman on the street, car keys in hand, walking to camera as he says.

Child Business

Man: I need the car in the morning.

Visual: Cut to see the child get in the car in the driver's seat. Rear vision mirror reflection shows the driver is a man. *SUPER*: Drink driving? Grow up.
