

STREETS AHEAD

Keeping left

We know drivers can get agitated by others who fail to keep left, but did you know you can be fined for staying in the right lane?

In WA, on multi-lane roads with a speed limit of 90km/h or more, you must keep left unless overtaking, turning right, making a U-turn or avoiding an obstruction.

You may also use the right lane if the left lane is:

- A special purpose lane, (e.g. bus lane, bicycle lane);
- A turning lane and you are going straight ahead; or
- Congested with traffic.
