Signaling in roundabouts

Knowing how to correctly signal when entering and exiting roundabouts is a notable area of confusion amongst WA drivers. Do you know the rules?

Turning left: On approach, indicate left from the left lane. Stay in and exit the roundabout from the same lane.

Driving straight ahead: No need to indicate on approach. Enter in either the left or right lane, stay in and exit from the same lane. Indicate left when you've passed the last exit before the one you intend to use.

Turning right or making a full turn: On approach, indicate right from the right lane. Stay in and exit the roundabout from this lane. Indicate left when you've passed the last exit before the one you intend to use.

Remember to always obey traffic lane arrows when entering, travelling in or exiting a roundabout.
