Driving in wet conditions

With significant rainfall forecast for Perth and the South West this weekend, it's a timely reminder to always drive to the conditions.

It's critical you can see and be seen in the rain. Turn your headlights on, clean your windscreen, replace worn windscreen wipers and use your air conditioner to stop your windscreen 'misting up'.

You will need to be especially observant while driving in the rain as pedestrians, cyclists and motorcyclists can be more difficult to see.

Also ensure that you allow extra distance when following another vehicle. It takes longer to stop when the road is wet.
